### ***Kamarajar's Birthday***

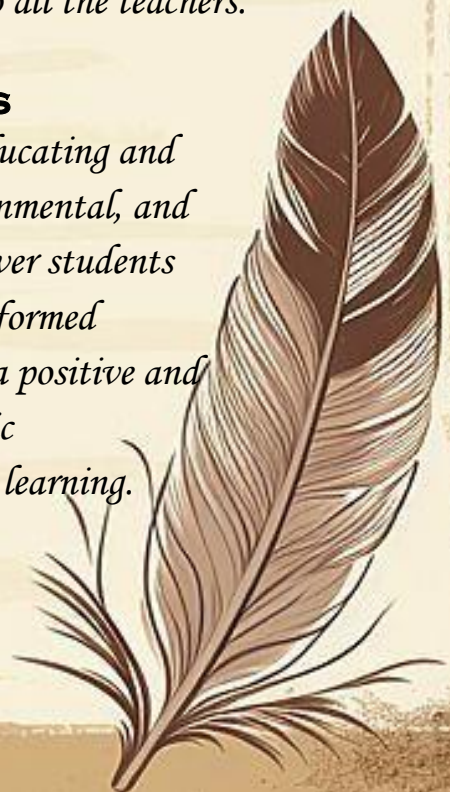

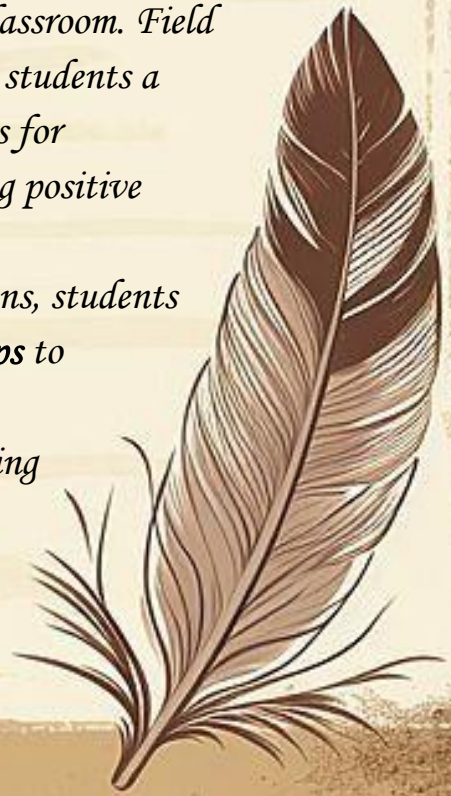
